OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Enhancement of service charges permitted under Emigration Rules, 1983.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the above subject and to say that a large number of representations had been received by the Government for enhancement of the service charges to defray the costs incurred by the registered recruitment agents to give advertisements, hold interviews and trade tests as well as scouting to select suitable and trained candidates for Overseas Employment. The Government has considered all the requests received and approved the enhancement of the service charges from existing Rs. 20,000/- to Rs. 30,000/-, subject to certain conditions and submission of an "Undertaking" to the jurisdictional Protector of Emigrants. The detailed Notification No. GSR 1510 (E) dated 14th December, 2017 is enclosed. All registered recruitment agents are directed to comply with the provisions of the aforesaid notification.
