JOB DESCRIPTION ¹

The tasks a Bath Attendant is expected to perform include:

- Attending to clients taking bath and administering elementary massage to improve their sense of well being
- Preparing water or steam bath and attending to clients during bathing, if required
- Rubbing the client's body with soap and sponge to clean the pores of skin
- Assisting the client in taking a shower or pouring water to wash off soap from body, if required
- Helping clients in drying their body with towel

WORK ENVIRONMENT ^{5, 2}

- It requires physical activity
- Need not handle a team
- Local travelling is not a part of this job role
- Part-time work and contractual jobs are available
- Work from home option is not available

Working hours

- Salons and spas usually work for 5/6 days a week for 8/9 hours everyday. This may vary from salon to salon
- Shift system may be available
- Overtime may be required
