## JOB DESCRIPTION <sup>1</sup>

The tasks an Accident Officer, Tram is expected to perform include:

- Conducting inquiries of tram accidents and submitting a detailed report for further action
- Visiting the site of the accident to assess any loss of human life and/or damage to property
- Assessing the situation by noting the loss of life and contacting the injured people to provide medical aid
- Informing the next of kin of the people involved in an accident
- Attending court proceedings for claims and assisting the police with the investigation

## WORK ENVIRONMENT <sup>2</sup>

- It needs one to be on their toes
- Need not handle a team
- Local travelling is a part of this job role
- Part-time work and contractual jobs may be available in some cities
- Work from home option is not available
