JOB DESCRIPTION ¹

The tasks a Carpet Embosser is expected to perform include:

- Trimming the edges of floral designs or patterns on carpets to give a raised appearance
- Spreading the carpet on an even surface
- Cutting wool on floral designs with hand scissors to give a raised appearance to the design
- Chalking around or stencilling the outline of designs on carpets and creating an embossed effect by clipping wool either wholly under or wholly outside the design

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- It is a not a field job
- Need not handle a team
- Local travelling is not a part of this job
- Part-time work and contractual jobs are available in some cities
- Work from home option is not available

Working hours

- Being self-employed is an option. In this case, the working hours and days will be flexible
